This is a list of supplies your child needs to bring on the first day of school in September. This is what your child needs.

Supplies: Grade 6,7 & 8(math/homeroom)

1. Texas Instrument TI 34 or TI 30x IIS solar-powered calculators. (Grade 8 students should already have this calculator, only one allowed for the state tests) All students must have a calculator in September.
2. A graph paper notebook .5cm
3. Protractor
4. Compass – Staedtler Geometry Set
5. Colored Pencils/thin markers
6. Glue sticks
7. ruler
8. Pocket Thesaurus Roget's or Merriam Webster yellow book (Staples has them)
9. tracing paper
10. safety scissor -Wescott is a good brand
11. Kleenex tissues, Boys (8th grade homeroom)
12. Disinfectant wipes/hand sanitizer Girls(8th grade homeroom)
13. Paper towels (8th grade homeroom)

**5-3 subject notebooks, pencil cases, pens, looseleaf, &1-8 pocket folder and subscription to Scholastic Math Magazine. Please do not purchase these items for your child.**
