

SUMMER READING - GRADE 1 GOING TO GRADE 2

It is important that your children keep up their reading skills over the summer. In order to do this the children will have a **REQUIRED READING ASSIGNMENT**. This assignment will count as their first grade in ELA for the first trimester. Make sure you write your first and last name on all of the assignments.

-The **first** requirement is to read five days per week for twenty minutes (20) each day. Please record this on the Reading Logs attached.

-The **second** requirement is to read the two fiction books which are listed below:
