GRADE 2 GOING INTO GRADE 3

It is important that your children keep up their reading skills over the summer. In order to do this the children will have a **REQUIRED READING ASSIGNMENT**. This will count as their first grade in ELA for the first trimester. The assignment will be due on the first day of school.

1. Your child is required to read 30 minutes a day and fill in the Reading Logs attached.
2. The reading requirement is to read: *Ghost Buddy: Zero to Hero*, by Henry Winkler & Lin Oliver.

*****Please remember all children should be reading to an adult to ensure comprehension.

3. The **final requirement** will be for your child to write a weekly journal entry. They can write about something that he or she did during the week. You must include a picture. The picture can be a drawing (which needs to be colored in) or a regular photograph. Your child will complete eight journal entries, one a week for the months of July and August. You can use loose leaf or a notebook. It will be graded and it is due on the first day of school.

Grading will be based on the following: Neatness, appropriate paper, use of capitalization, punctuation, and sentence structure. I am looking forward to another prosperous year with your children.
